Are you submitting an application to the National Institutes of Health (NIH) soon? Has it been awhile since you submitted to NIH? The University utilizes the InfoEd system for submitting applications to NIH. InfoEd Proposal Development (PD) pre-populates forms, provides validations to insure an error-free submission, transmits application electronically, and stores the proposal securely for future reference.
